She (the resident) was on the other side of the building, and when she arrived, she was out of breath, and I could just tell that she was not ready to talk about what the patient needed to talk about. Now let it out very slowly. Again." We did this a few times until the Medical Resident was calm. She said to me, "are you for real?" I said, "I am." Now you are calm, and relaxed, and able to hear what the patient needs to tell you." Three minutes.

My mind has been all over the place, and with everything going on around the country and the world, I find it very hard to focus. The three minute vacation – which I literally just thought up when the Medical Resident walked into the room, sounds like just the think I need during the day. Maybe we all do. A time to gather our breath, and our thoughts, and our prayers, and just be grounded, amidst all the swirling energy – negative and positive – around us.

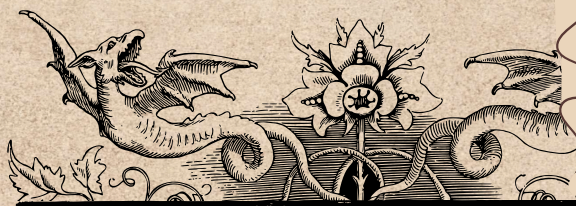
# ANCIENT SCHOOLS OF THOUGHT SERIES

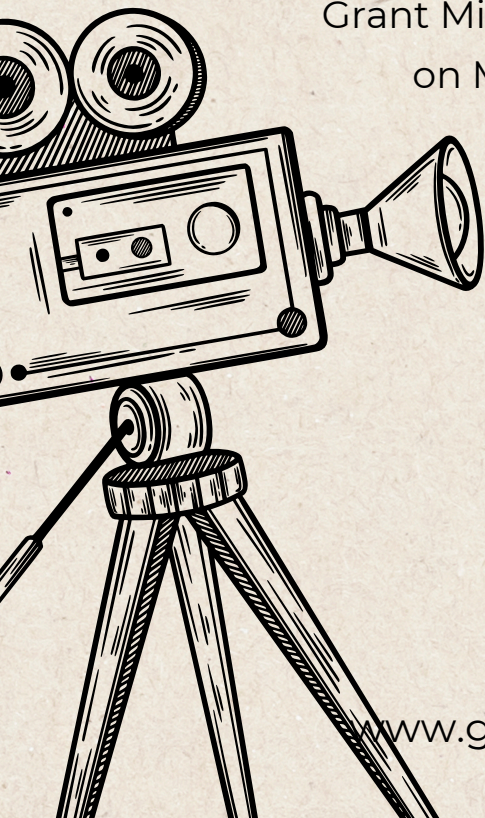
