This past Sunday, in worship, we spoke about the impending construction project on Southway. This project has begun, so here are the updates, pertaining to that project:

- Traffic has been reduced to one lane in each direction, utilizing the center lanes
- The church parking lot IS FULLY ACCESSIBLE
- The parking lot across the street from the church IS FULLY ACCESSIBLE; HOWEVER, they have begun filling the lot with construction equipment and other necessary items, so a limited number of spaces will be available on Sunday morning. If the lot is full, THE LOWER LOT OF GREENDALE HIGH SCHOOL IS AVAILABLE TO US AND WE WILL HAVE SHUTTLES RUNNING FROM 9:10 a.m UNTIL THE BEGINNING OF WORSHIP AT 9:30 a.m.
- The Board of Trustees asks that the parking on CLOVER LANE be reserved for those with the greatest mobility issues. Please remember, when parking, to pull up all the way to the “no parking” signs, and if you are pulling in behind another car, to pull in as close as possible. If we do that, we are able to park 15 cars on Clover Lane (which is not a lot).
