It is called Gaudete Sunday, or The Sunday of Joy, or in some traditions, Turning Sunday. It is when we realize we are closer to Christmas, Closer to the turning of the season, Closer to receiving the story (that incredible story) again. But, I wonder if the turning doesn't also have something to do with last week's lesson about the baptist's cry at the Jordan River – when he shouted in Hebrew (because that is what he spoke, "Shuv!!!" "Turn" "Take a New Path – one that takes you closer to God!!" Maybe those ancient mystics, and poets, and storytellers, and monks, and nuns, and the desert abbas and ammas knew something that we have lost touch of – that that there is always time to stop, look, listen, and TURN, and come closer to God.


